Main grape varieties:

Vidal Blanc – Vidal Blanc is a productive white wine grape with small berries borne on very large, compact tapering clusters. Late spring bud break, good cold hardiness, and well suited for a variety of climatic and soil conditions.

Triminette - A late mid-season white wine grape which produces wine with pronounced varietal character likened to one of its parents, 'Gewürztraminer'.

Barbera – Produces good yields, and is known for deep color, low tannins, and high acidity when grown in hot climates. Barbera produces an intense red wine, with a fruity, floral nose and distinct flavor of red fruits and black cherries.
